Making public transport safe for women. EMTUSA, Empresa Municipal de Transportes Urbanos Gijón, offers on-demand night bus stops on Friday and Saturday nights, and daily during summertime.

This service is available on the four night (búho/owl) lines which operate throughout the city from 11 pm to 6 am.

Women traveling alone on the night bus service can request that the driver drops them off at any safe point along the route. As these are not official bus stops, the drop-off must always be agreed in advance with the driver in order to ensure that it is a safe point at which to disembark.
